HMB HERITAGE TRAIL

This is an opportunity for old scholars who wish to take part in the Heritage Trail.

The Heritage trail will take place over two weeks, departing from Durban Harbour and returning to Hermannsburg school, going via New Germany and New Hanover enroute. The planned dates are 17 November to 01 December 2019. The trail follows, as closely as possible, the original route used by the German settlers who founded Hermannsburg. It will be self-propelled in the main, and will incorporate hiking, mountain-biking and canoeing.

There will be a trained guide and facilitator on the trail at all times and medical support on call so there will be sufficient back-up and care in place. Two staff members will accompany the scholars taking part, and we would love for some old scholars to join us on this inaugural trail. Lee Fuller who is organising the trail on the school's behalf, has over a decade of experience arranging and guiding tour groups and school groups on these kind of experiences and we have great faith in his organisation.

The estimated cost is R8 000 per participant, this may vary slightly in the final costing depending on sponsorships and other decisions made over the next couple of months.

There is limited space available, but we have space for about 8 old scholars if they would like to take part. Should you wish to take part please let Mr Harbottle know via email on wecare@hmbschool.co.za by 07 June. Thereafter communication concerning details, deposits, equipment etc. will be sent out.

We intend that this Heritage trail, will become an important bridge between the past and the present and a rite of passage for every Hermannsburg scholar in future.

We think this is going to be a fantastic growth opportunity and hope many of you will take part.
